

Next Wednesday and Friday from 1.30 - 4pm you will have the chance to talk with your child's teacher. These parental consultations mark the half way mark of the school year and will provide an opportunity to discuss your child's development and progress and agree targets for the second half of the school year.

Appointments will be sent out by class teachers over the next few days. Please contact the school if you are unable to attend during these times and we will arrange an appointment on a more convenient day and time.

It was fantastic that 97% of parents/carers attended consultations last Autumn. This willingness to work in partnership with school to support your child's educational progress and all round development is hugely influential and very much appreciated.

During the time spent with teachers there will be an opportunity to complete a short questionnaire. This will help the school use your views to help plan for the future. Indeed parent views have led us to plan changes to our breakfast club. The main change is that as from half term the club will begin at 7.30am instead of 8.15am, with the cost remaining at 50p each day.
