SCHOOL MEALS NOTICE

As you are aware a school meal at lunchtime is a great way to ensure your child receives a nutritionally balanced meal that supports their development and learning. If you get any of the following support payments your child may be entitled to receive free school meals:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseekers Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit

If you are unsure whether you are entitled to Free School Meals please contact the school office for an the application form or phone the school meals department at Stockton Borough Council on 526606. You may not be aware that the school receives over £900 per year for each child that is entitled to Free School meals or has been entitled in the last 6 years. Even if your child prefers to bring a packed lunch, if you think they may be entitled to free school meals please do make an application as the whole school will benefit from this.
