HEADTEACHER'S NEWS

We are excited and proud to announce that the FS1 (Nursery) building is going to be transformed. Our school and Stockton Borough Council have been working together to create a wonderful extension to the current building, so that the school can offer places to 2 year old children. The plans are to build onto the current building, giving more space inside and modern facilities for all the children.

We are working very hard to make sure that Tilery Primary School has the best FS1 building to support children's learning with the opportunity to offer some additional places for 2 year old children.

This does mean that there will be some disruption while the building work is being carried out. We would like to make sure that the children who currently use the building are still able to come to school and enjoy FS1. Therefore FS1 (Nursery) will be moving temporarily to the small hall next to FS2 (Reception).

We have just heard that the builders may start work on Monday 25th November, therefore staff will need to move all the equipment and resources over to the hall and set up ready for the children to come in, so for this reason we have made the decision to close FS1 for two days on *Thursday 21st and Friday 22nd November*.

If the 2 days closure causes you any difficulties please speak to a member of staff and we will try to help. I am sure you will agree that it will be worth it when the children are able to move back in after the building work has been completed in April 2014.

Can we thank you for your understanding and patience during this time. It will all be worth it when the children have an amazing new building.
