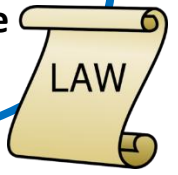
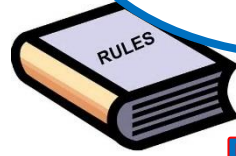
These values are taught through Personal, Social, Health and Emotional (PSHE), Religious Education (RE), daily collective worship and across our broad curriculum.
