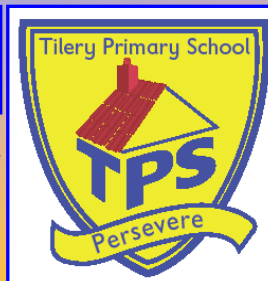

FREE SCHOOL MEALS REMINDER

Your child might be able to get free school meals if you get any of the following:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit

Even if your child is in Reception, Y1 & Y2 and they receive a free school meal as part of the universal free school meal scheme, we will receive extra funding from the government for all pupils who are entitled to FSM. It takes seconds to complete an application form and the office staff will be happy to help if you have any questions.
