## FREE SCHOOL MEAL ENTITLEMENT

Pupils whose parents receive the following support payments are entitled to receive free school meals:

Income Support  
Income based Jobseekers Allowance  
Income related Employment and Support Allowance  
Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999  
The Guaranteed element of Pension Credit  
Child Tax Credit (provided you're not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)  
Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit  
Universal credit

Stockton Borough Council will check your entitlement using the free school meals checking service (ECS) provided by the Department for Education and contact you to confirm your eligibility. In the meantime you must continue to pay for all your child's school meals.

### APPLY FOR FREE SCHOOL MEALS

If you would like to apply for free school meals, please contact the Free School Meals Team on telephone: 01642 526606 for an instant decision or complete the online free school meal application form.

To complete the online application form you will be asked for your contact details, National Insurance Number, date of birth and the name and date of birth of children attending school.
