Dairy dates; Friday 5th April will be a Toy Day for pupils and also the day we break up for our Easter Holiday.


Tuesday 23rd April the summer term begins.

There will be a few paper copies distributed throughout the school, if you wish to receive a copy, please speak to the office staff and will be more than happy to print you one out.




Lost Property
