I hope you can make the best of the lovely weather this weekend despite the lockdown!

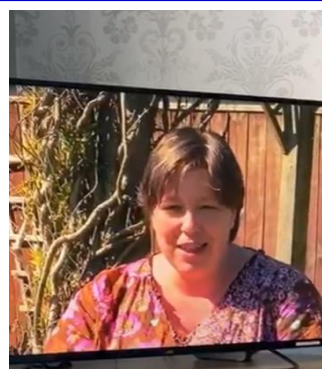
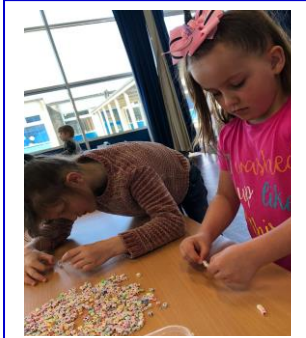
