	First...	Then...	Challenge!
Reading	Read aloud to an adult or an older brother or sister - every day if you can!	On the Oxford Owl website read " Pirate Poems ". Remember to click on "audio" to help you with any tricky words.	Which is your favourite poem? What did you like about it? How many pairs of rhyming words can you find in your favourite poem?
Spelling	This week we will be looking at rhyming words. These are two words that sound the same, like slug and jug. Play Cake Bake to practise finding rhymes.	Now visit Education City to match rhyming words.	Challenge! How many words can you think of that rhyme with: • hat • got • all • king • lock • bell
Writing	Watch the hilarious Michael Rosen read his poem " Chocolate Cake ".	Write a poem about your favourite food. Remember that not all poems have to rhyme! It could be a description of how your food looks, tastes and makes you feel.	"Chocolate cake" doesn't rhyme but it is still a poem. Why do you think this is? What makes it different to a story? Michael Rosen explains how he performs his poems here .
Maths	This week we will be looking at multiplying numbers. Warm up by counting in 2s, 5s, 10s. Use a hundred square to help you. If you would like a challenge then count in 3s or 4s.	Now visit Education City to practice your times tables. Or practice them on Times Tables Rock Stars . 	Dance along to your times tables with BBC supermovers!
