GOVERNORS NEWS

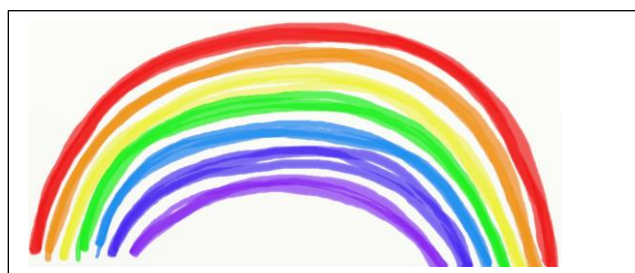

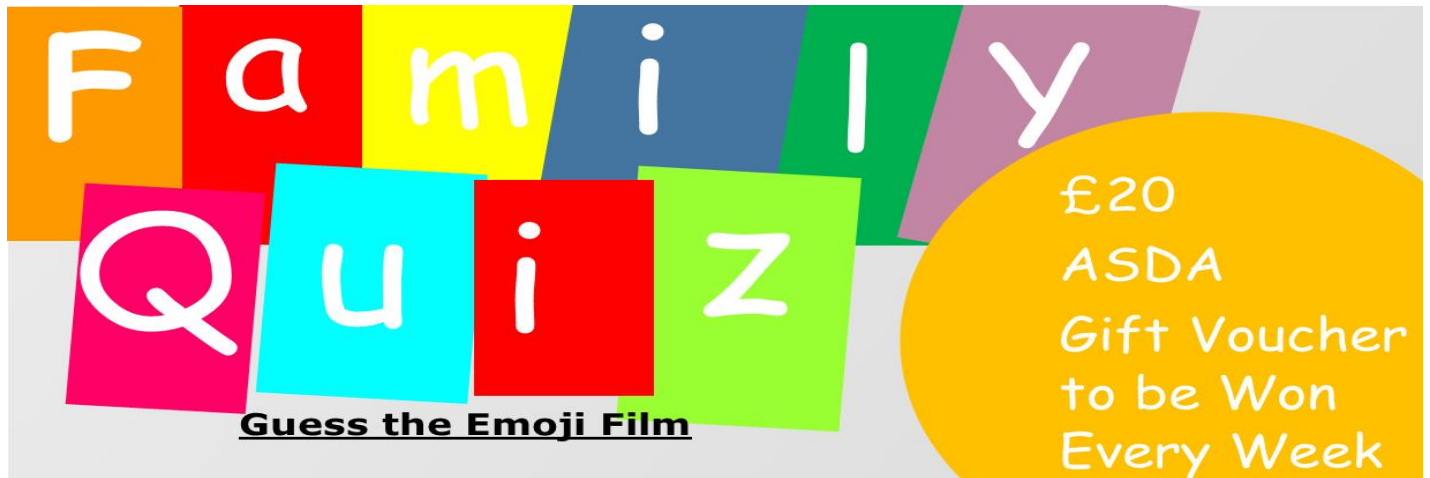
