Our Eco-Warriors have continued to work hard this month.

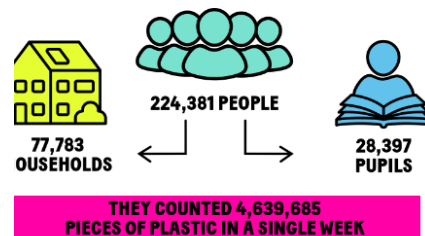
River Tees
